In 2013, she completed the Turid Rugaas Internationals Dog Trainers Education. With Turid's support she started a study of her own about horses. Her study lead to the description of 20 calming signals horses use to appease others and calm themselves to keep a positive social climate and avoid negative escalations. She is the author of Language Signs & Calming Signals of Horses (2017) and Scentwork for Horses (2020).

Dr. Murrow is a licensed psychologist who leads Connection Therapy, a private practice focused on serving rural communities in Kansas. Prior to practicing in Kansas, Dr. Murrow completed a Postdoctoral Fellowship at the Reiss-Davis Child Study Center in Los Angeles. She also is a core faculty member and Research Coordinator at Pacifica Graduate Institute where she teaches courses in psychological assessment, theory, and research. She shares psychological concepts in an accessible way through her podcast, Connection Therapy.
